GOVERNMENT MOTIONS

1. Hon. Mr. Cathers (Motion #25)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to support development of the agriculture sector with actions including:

- (1) working with farmers and industry associations including Yukon Agriculture Association and the Grower's of Organic Food Yukon to implement the Agriculture Multi-Year Development Plan,
- (2) developing a "Yukon-Grown Food Policy" aimed at significantly increasing the production and use of locally-grown vegetables, meat and food products,
- (3) supporting the development of agriculture infrastructure that improves food security, facilitates access to market, and encourages local production of food,
- (4) supporting the development of local markets for Yukon agriculture products through measures including increasing the annual funding for the Fireweed Community Market; and
- (5) working with Yukon farmers to conduct agricultural research.

GOVERNMENT MOTIONS

1. Hon. Mr. Cathers (Motion #46)

THAT, the Standing Orders of the Yukon Legislative Assembly be amended by adding the following standing order:

76(7) The provisions of this Standing Order shall apply to an interim supply appropriation bill on the final sitting day prior to the end of the fiscal year in which the bill is introduced.

MOTIONS OTHER THAN GOVERNMENT MOTIONS

1. Mr. Hassard (Motion #36)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to modernize the legislation related to the land titles process to utilize technology and to improve the timeliness of transferring land titles.

2. Mr. Elias (Motion #37)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to provide stable and long-term funding to the Whitehorse Food Bank to ensure the Whitehorse Food Bank does not have to rely solely upon volunteer contributions to finance its operations.

3. Mr. Elias (Motion #38)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to give a status report on the 33 “Actions to be undertaken” contained in the Yukon Government Climate Change Action Plan.

4. Mr. Elias (Motion #39)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to table a progress report on what targets have actually been met from the February 2009 Yukon Government Climate Change Action Plan.

5. Mr. Elias (Motion #40)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to immediately create a system for registering paid lobbyists, as recommended by the Conflict of Interest Commissioner in his annual reports to the Legislative Assembly.

6. Ms. White (Motion #41)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to provide leadership on protecting Yukon’s environment by:

- (1) re-establishing the Yukon Council on the Economy and the Environment,
- (2) introducing species at risk legislation,
- (3) developing a wetlands conservation strategy; and
- (4) updating the *Environment Act*.

7. Ms. White (Motion #42)

THAT this House urges the Government of Canada to provide international leadership in addressing climate change and to not abandon efforts to establish emission reduction targets for greenhouse gases as required in the Kyoto Protocol.

8. Mr. Tredger (Motion #43)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to develop a comprehensive Water Strategy for the protection of water resources and the environment which addresses:

- (1) source water protection, including surface and groundwater,
- (2) protection of wetlands and headwaters,
- (3) restriction of deleterious land uses that may contaminate drinking water sources,
- (4) restriction of bulk water exports,
- (5) protection of drinking water; and
- (6) data collection, monitoring and training.

9. Mr. Silver (Motion #44)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to make any necessary legislative or regulatory changes to allow Extended Scope Nurses to practice to the full extent of their capabilities and training in either a nursing station or a hospital.

10. Mr. Silver (Motion #45)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to proceed, based on recommendations contained in the "Minority Report on Whistle-Blower Protection", with drafting whistle-blower protection legislation.
