- (2) developing a "Yukon-Grown Food Policy" aimed at significantly increasing the production and use of locally-grown vegetables, meat and food products,
- (3) supporting the development of agriculture infrastructure that improves food security, facilitates access to market, and encourages local production of food,
- (4) supporting the development of local markets for Yukon agriculture products through measures including increasing the annual funding for the Fireweed Community Market; and
- (5) working with Yukon farmers to conduct agricultural research.

1. Mr. Elias (Motion #98)

THAT this House urges the Minister of Highways and Public Works to work with the community of Old Crow, the Vuntut Gwitchin Government, the Vuntut Gwitchin Limited Partnership, the private sector and industry to build a winter road from the Dempster Highway to Old Crow in 2013 that is capable of accommodating light truck traffic.

2. Ms. McLeod (Motion #99)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to continue to implement the Energy Strategy for Yukon to promote a sustainable and secure energy future.

3. Ms. White (Motion #100)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to:

- (1) consult with youth organizations, the Skookum Jim Friendship Centre, Many Rivers Counselling and Support Services, and First Nations Governments to determine the need, location, and ongoing funding for a youth shelter in Whitehorse,
- (2) recognize that requirements for youth are different from the general population; and
- (3) develop a plan to open a youth shelter by September, 2012.

4. Mr. Silver (Motion #101)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to respond to local not-for-profit and private industry interest in remediating the John Korbo Apartment Building site in Dawson City so that the location may be used for a new affordable housing project.
