1. Hon. Mr. Cathers (Motion #25)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to support development of the agriculture sector with actions including:

- (1) working with farmers and industry associations including Yukon Agriculture Association and the Grower's of Organic Food Yukon to implement the Agriculture Multi-Year Development Plan,
- (2) developing a "Yukon-Grown Food Policy" aimed at significantly increasing the production and use of locally-grown vegetables, meat and food products,
- (3) supporting the development of agriculture infrastructure that improves food security, facilitates access to market, and encourages local production of food,
- (4) supporting the development of local markets for Yukon agriculture products through measures including increasing the annual funding for the Fireweed Community Market; and
- (5) working with Yukon farmers to conduct agricultural research.

2. Hon. Mr. Dixon (Motion #119)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to develop and implement a Yukon Water Strategy that will help provide long-term direction for economically and environmentally responsible development, management, and use of water in Yukon and establish principles to guide future decision making.

**NOTICE PAPER****MOTIONS OTHER THAN GOVERNMENT MOTIONS**

1. Ms. McLeod (Motion #148)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to continue using technology to make more Government services available on-line and to improve existing on-line services.

2. Ms. McLeod (Motion #149)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to use the 2012/13 Budget to provide \$1.86 million to extend the Licenced Practical Nurse program at Yukon College until 2016.

3. Mr. Hassard (Motion #150)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to use the 2012/13 Budget to allocate an additional \$457,000 to the Home Care program to meet the significant growth in client numbers and complexity of care needs.

4. Mr. Hassard (Motion #151)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to continue to invest in Yukon's transportation infrastructure including:

- (1) \$15 million under the Shakwak project for the Haines Road and north Alaska Highway and a further \$1 million from the Yukon Government for the north Alaska Highway,
- (2) \$7.25 million for reconstruction of the Campbell Highway from km 10 to 190 and a further \$1.5 million for surfacing,
- (3) \$1.6 million to replace culverts at Too Much Gold Creek and All Gold Creek on the Klondike Highway,
- (4) \$1.45 million to improve safety and road conditions in the North Canol Road,
- (5) \$2.6 Million for reconstruction, BST and re-vegetation work on the Atlin Road; and
- (6) \$2 million for the Takhini Hotsprings Road reconstruction.

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to take into consideration the latest information on the causal linkages between hydraulic fracturing and earthquakes, including the following tabled reports:

- (1) Examination of Possibly Induced Seismicity from Hydraulic Fracturing in the Eola Field, Garvin County, Oklahoma. Oklahoma Geological Survey, Open-File Report OF1-2011, August 2011,
- (2) Preliminary Report on the Northstar 1 Class II Injection Well and Seismic Events in the Youngstown, Ohio, Area. Ohio Department of Natural Resources, March 2012; and
- (3) The SEAB Shale Gas Production Subcommittee Ninety-Day Report - August 11, 2011. The Shale Gas Subcommittee of the Secretary of Energy Advisory Board. August 2011.
